Tips to get the most out of your day on the ocean

## PLAN AHEAD




Always be on time - the fish wait for no one! If you're early - you're on time If you're on time - you're late If you're late - you'll be left behind

Pack a light snack and plenty of water

Call Captain Mark the afternoon before your trip for any last minute details or information

We meet in the Cape Kiwanda beach parking lot right along side of the Pelican Pub. We suggest knowing where this location is prior to the morning of the trip to avoid being late Launch site location/map available on Contact page of website

## BE PREPARED



Bring a warm jacket regardless of weather forecast (rain gear is a huge plus)

Wearing close-toed shoes is a must on board - water proof shoes or boots are optimal

Dress comfortably: layers are helpful, it's cold on the water and warm on the shore

Stow large cooler(s) in your vehicle for taking home your catch of fish/crab

Be sure to bring your ID & signed waiver (available on website) Also bring your fishing license and if you want to crab then a shellfish license is required as well

## BE RESPONSIBLE



Sobriety is non-negotiable - no drugs or alcohol allowed on board. If you are not sober, you are not going fishing

If you need seasick medication, we recommend taking a dose the night before your trip as well as the morning of for most effectiveness

Be sure to use sunscreen to protect yourself, and wash hands thoroughly after applying. Sunscreen scent will ruin everyone's day of fishing
